



HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS: NOW ACCEPTING **APPLICATIONS FOR YOUTH TRIPS!**



All-expenses-paid leadership trips to Washington, D.C., and Steamboat Springs, Colorado, are available for high school juniors whose parents or guardians are members of Western Cooperative Electric.

The top four students will have the opportunity to attend Electric Cooperative Youth Tour in Washington, D.C., or the Cooperative Youth Leadership Camp near Steamboat Springs, Colorado.

CONTESTANTS MUST COMPLETE THE APPLICATION BY JAN. 10, 2024. Upon receipt of the application, contestants will be mailed an entry packet.

Finalists are scored and selected based on a short essay, an open-book guiz, and a remote interview. The student with the top scores gets the first selection of trips.

INTERESTED IN SERVING AS A **WESTERN TRUSTEE?**

Those members who meet the qualifications have the right to seek election to the board of trustees. Western will hold elections for trustees prior to Western Cooperative's 79th Annual Meeting on May 8, 2024.

While serving on a board is certainly not for everyone, it is healthy for any co-op to have an engaged membership with members interested in serving in a leadership role. At Western Coop, we are governed by a board of nine trustees elected by the membership to provide strategic guidance and ensure we continue to serve the member's interests.

To run for a trustee position, candidates:

- ▶ Must be a member of Western Cooperative Electric.
- ► Cannot be employed by or financially interested in a competing enterprise or a business selling electric energy or supplies to the cooperative.
- ► Cannot be a current employee or have been employed by the cooperative within the last five years.
- Must be a bona fide resident within Western's service territory.

Nominations must be submitted by March 1.
