ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, citizens of Ellis, Trego and Gove Counties in the State of Kansas, hereby associate curselves together in order to create, form, establish and organize a cooperative, nonprofit, membership corporation for the purpose of supplying electric energy and promoting and extending the use thereof as provided by and in accordance with Article 46 of Chapter 17 of the 1943 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas for 1935, known as "The Electric Co-operative Act", and laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

First. The name of the proposed corporation shall be: THE WESTERN COOPERATIVE ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, INC.,

Second. The place where the principal office or place of business of said corpor ation is to be located is: Wakeeney, Trego County, Kansas.

Third. The names and addresses of the incorporators are as follows, t0-wit:

Fourth. The names and addresses of its trustees are as follows, to-wit:

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Fifth. This corporation is not organized for profit and the nature of the business, and the objects and purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried on are as follows; to-wit:

- (a) To sue and be sued in its corporate name.
- (b) To have perpetual existence.
- (c) To adopt a corporate seal and alter the same.
- (d) To generate, manufacture, purchase, acquire, accumulate, and transmit electric energy, and to distribute, sell, supply, and dispose of electric energy to its members, and to governmental agencies, political subdivisions, and to other persons, who are not receiving central station service from facilities of existing public utilities.
- (e) To assist members by the financing thereof, to whom electric energy is or will be supplied by the cooperative, in wiring their premises and in acquiring and installing electrical and plumbing appliances, equipment, fixtures, and apparatus, and for demonstration purposes, purchase, acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, electric and plumbing appliances, equipment, fixtures and apparatus and to sell same when it has served such purpose.
- (f) To construct, purchase, lease, and to equip, maintain and operate, and to sell, assign, convey, lease, mortgage, pledge or encumber electric transmission and distribution lines or systems, electric generating plants, and lands, buildings, structures, dams, easements and rights of way, equipment, and any other real or personal property, tangible or intangible, necessary to accomplish the purpose of which this cooperative is organized.
- (g) To purchase, lease as lessee, or otherwise acquire, and to use, and exercise and to sell, assign, convey, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of or encumber, franchises, rights, privileges, licenses and easements.
- (h) To borrow money and otherwise contract indebtedness, and to issue notes, bonds, and other evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage, pledge, or deed of trust of, or any other encumberance upon, any or all of its them-owned or after-acquired real or personal property, assets, franchises, revenues or income.
- (i) To construct, maintain and operate electric transmission and distribution lines along, upon, under and across publicly owned lands and public thoroughfares, roads, nigmways, streets, alleys, bridges and causeways in conformity with the laws of the State of Kansas.
- (j) To exercise the power of eminent domain in the manner provided by the laws of this state for the exercise of such power by other corporations constructing or operating electric transmission and distribution lines or systems.

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- (k) To become a member of other cooperatives, and conduct its business and exercise its powers within this state.
- (1) To a dopt, amend and repeal bylaws.
- (m) To do and perform any other acts and things, and to have and exercise any other powers which may be necessary, to accomplish the purpose for which this cooperative is organized.

Sixth. The length of time for which said cooperative corporation is to exist shall be perpetual.

Seventh. (a) This cooperative is formed not for profit and shall not have capital stock but the capital structure of the cooperative shall consist of the aggregate amount standing to the credit of members on account of the membership interests alloted to them which shall not exceed five thousand dollars and one thousand memberships of the value of five dollars each, and the maximum amount of membership interest to be held by one person, partnership or corporation shall not exceed five dollars. (b) Each incorporator of this cooperative is a member hereof and has paid his membership fee of five dollars, and other persons, partnerships and corporations may not become members hereof unless and until they shall pay said membership fee of five dollars and agree to use electric energy or other services furnished by the cooperative when they are made available through its facilities and the bylaws may provide additional qualifications and limitations in respect of membership. (c) The apportionment of earnings and the manner in which the distribution of sernings shall be determined and paid to the members shall be as set forth in the bylaws of this cooperative.

Eight. The number of trustees of this corporation small be nine (9) and the names and residences of the membership of the cooperative who shall compose the first Eoard of Trustees, and who shall hold office until the first annual meeting of the members of the cooperative and until their successors small be elected and shall have qualified, are as hereinbefore stated and set forth.

Ninth. The Board of Trustees shall adopt the first bylaws of this cooperative and thereafter the members shall adopt, amend or repeal the bylaws by the affirmative vote of a majority of those members voting thereon at a meeting of the members. The bylaws shall set forth the rights and duties of members and trustees and may contain other provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the cooperative not inconsistent with law or these articles of incorporation.

Tenth. We further state that the above application and articles of incorporation are made in good faith, with the intention that said corporation shall actually engage in the business specified, and none other.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

OF

The Western Cooperative Electric Association, Inc. executed pursuant to the Electric Cooperative Act, Kansas General Statutes (Supp. 1943) Article 46, Section 17-4601 et seq.

The Western Cooperative Electric Association, Inc., a cooperative, non-profit, membership corporation incorporated under the Electric Cooperative Act, Kansas General Statutes (Supp. 1943) Article 46, Section 17-4601 et seq., hereby certifies and states as follows:

FIRST: The name of the Cooperative is, The Western Cooperative Electric Association, Inc.

SECOND: The address of its principal office is, WaKeeney, Kansas

THIRD: The articles of incorporation are hereby amended by the adoption of the following resolution by the unaminous vote of the members of said cooperative: "Resolved, That paragraph Seventh of the Articles of Incorporation be, and the same hereby is repealed in its entirety and that paragraphs Eighth, Ninth, and Tenth of the Articles of Incorporation be, and the same hereby are redesignated paragraphs Seventh, Eighth, and Ninth respectively.
